This little quote has meant a lot to us this year. In January we stepped out in faith and booked 30 tickets for this summer's summit teams. As time went on we often wondered had we been too adventurous as it looked like we would not be able to fill the places and thus lose our deposit. God was faithful, as always, and did not fail us. He directed wonderful young and older people to fill our team to the Philippines in July and then to Brazil in August. He answered many prayers and overcame many obstacles, not only for us, but for our summiteers. He increased our faith and challenged and changed people's view of missions and the role that God might have them to do in reaching the world for Christ. We are delighted that six former summiteers started Bible school this semester.

In North Luzon in the Philippines our team had the job of digging ditches to lay hoses to bring water down to the village from a mountain spring. In the dry season, both the people and the missionaries were short of water so putting in this water supply has been a blessing to everyone. Our prayer now is that the Talbot family and their partner Christina Cannap can learn the language and culture and tell the people about the 'living water of life.'



Our project in Brazil was to remodel an old building and put a new roof on it. The man in charge of maintenance there was very grateful for all the work that was accomplished. He said it would have taken him 5 1/2 months to do what we did in 12 days. While we were there Angela came down with malaria which she either contracted in the Philippines or from years before in PNG. In an amazing way the Lord provided treatment through a missionary, on furlough from Guinea in Africa. She had brought a malaria treatment back to Brazil with her which she gave to Angela. She also informed us that had we gone to the hospital the military police would have come and quarantined the guest house and our team would not have been able to continue on to visit the tribe which was one of the highlights of our trip! What a mighty God we serve, He orchestrated medicine to come from Africa to Brazil to treat Angela from Northern Ireland!



We were thankful to get everyone home safe and sound at the end of August and to find our family in N.Ireland all well. We had a few days with Andrew before he went back to work at the Bible school at North Cotes. The Lord has led him to work as a volunteer in the kitchen there this year and he is enjoying learning many new things. Caleb started his third year as a trainee chef and enjoys working in the Vic Rynn café in Lisburn. He had a wonderful time in July working at an orphanage in Borneo. Rebekah is still nursing in Liverpool but is presently visiting missionary friends in Africa. Matthew passed his Australian electrician exams and has moved to Perth to work so our family are all over the place. We are glad we can place them in the Lord's faithful hands and though they are far from us we know they are under his watchful care.

We thank the Lord for the many opportunities we had this year to share in different meetings about our work. If you would like us to come and share about Summit we would love to do so. Our prayer is that the Lord would open young people's eyes to the many millions in the world who have not yet had the opportunity to hear about our wonderful Saviour.
